

RELEASE FOR STARS AND STRIPES

Joshua Starr, New York scholar who is visiting Germany to survey Nazi looted cultural objects, books and manuscripts from Jewish institutions, is scheduled to speak to the GI COUNCIL OF FRANKFURT on Wednesday, 16 June 1948, at 2000 hours, at the JWB Synagogue Center, 6 Elsa Brandstrom Strasse, Frankfurt.

Mr. Starr will describe the collection at the OMGUS Archival Depot at Offenbach and tell of some of the detective methods used in tracing the ownership of many of the valuable and irreplaceable works. As the representative of the Jewish Cultural Reconstruction Society his remarks are expected to shed light on the strange Nazi policy of extermination of Jews but preservation of their books.
