Dear attorney Epstein,

I just received letter from you (...). I am writing on my own because Henryk will be here in the evening, and I am very impatient. Yesterday we received a letter from Dr. Opatowski, in which he claims that he sent his testimony to Juridische Abteilung in Munchen about two weeks ago. When he asked us, in the previous letter, what he could do for us we wrote that he could write to Munchen, but we forgot to mention that this has to be signed by (...). When last Friday Henryk was called to the Jewish Council to respond to the indictment and when all of the unjust falsehoods were said about Henryk, I wrote to you and to Dr. Opatowski. I asked him to write back as soon as possible to Munchen and also I wrote that the Jewish Council needed to confirm that. The letter which we received yesterday was an answer on that. When we come to Munchen you will have a chance to read that. Yesterday I wrote to Mr. Wolowicz and because writing gives me relief, I also copied it down...
