Dear Mr. Wladyslaw:

For some reason your letter of February 19th reached us only this week.

I am moved by your plight and am very unhappy that someone who, at great personal risk, helped to save Jews during the Nazi occupation of Poland should find himself in a position where he needs to write the kind of letter that you addressed to this organization.

With the deepest regret, however, I must inform you that the World Jewish Congress has absolutely no financial resources which it could use to help even someone as deserving as you.

Congress is an international organization which, on a limited budget, strives to coordinate the activities of its affiliated Jewish communities in the cultural and political fields. Our resources are less than adequate even for these purposes and certainly do not permit the kind of expenditure envisaged by your letter.

I can only express the hope that you will be successful in finding the means to enable you to improve your situation and that of your family.
