with her parents and desiring, she still being a minor, to assure for her the status of French Citizen, he claims on her behalf French Citizenship according to the provisions of Article 52 of the French Citizenship Law.

In support of his declaration are attached: (1) Bulletin Nr.2 of the penal Registry; (2) a statement of morality and loyality; (3) a protocoll relating to assimilation;

(4) a medical certificate in conformity with the provision of Article 8,3 of the decret of 2nd November 1945. Mr. Kaufmann after having stated that he is not subject to an extradiction order nor to an order of forced domicile has presented his permit of residence and has submitted to us

(3) all documents proving his residence in France for the last five years.

These documents are attached to the declaration which will be submitted to the Ministry of Population to be registered there - the procedure being invalid without this formality.
