For the purpose of legal certification to the truth of what is to be specified herewith.

In the case of Mr. KOSOWSKI JOSEFH (son of Icchak, deceased), age 48, residing in Bari, IRO-Camp.

Before us, Dr. Apicella Mario, Prefect, assisted by the undersigned Registrar, the following withesses appeared. After informing them of the religious, moral and legal importance of the oath and consequences of false statements, the following was read to them: "Being aware of the responsibility which you are assuming with this oath before God and men, you swear that you will tell the truth, not/hing but the truth." The witnesses, standing and with uncovered head, one after the other, have pronounced the words "I swear".

Questioning the same witnesses regarding their personal data they replied to be:

- 1) Korczomker Lazar, son of Moses, age 26, from Pruzsana, Poland, residing in Bari, Iro Camp.
- 2) Arbeiter Motek, son of Isak, age 26, from Plock, Poland, residing in Bari, IRO Camp.
- 3) Skop Jacob, son of Szaja, age 40, from Olkusz, Poland, residing in Bari, IRO Camp.
- 4) Mina Strauch, daughter of Dizer, age 27, from Koszicze, Poland, residing in Bari, IRO Camp.
- 5) Kotok Judel, son of Meier, age 43, from Skydel, Poland, residing in Bari, IRO Camp.

After the above were duly sworn, they depose and say:

## DECLARATION

We can, with full conscience attest to the Publica and general as well as our own personal knowledge that:

On the day of 28 of December, 1942, HAVA BOJARSK, daughter of Aron and Rachel Low, born at Wolkowisk on June 20, 1910, wife of KOSOWSKI JOSEF, son of deceased Icchak and deceased Mira Andrejewska, born May 15, 1910 at Wolkowisk, was deported to a concentration camp in Treblinks, where she was killed, that the husband Kosowski, Josef because of the present international situation is unable to obtain his wife's death certificate from his country, which certificate is substituted with this Notarial Act.
