

DPA SERIES: THE NAZI HOLOCAUST - SERIES II — "The children were so pretty, . . . so well-made, that it was striking, when compared with the rags they were covered with. It happened in the second half of October 1944 . . . The children had noticed the smoke from the chimney and they realized that they were being led to their death. They began running hither and thither in the yard, in a dead fright, clutching their heads in despair . . ." The killing of children was a routine in the concentration camps.
