

DPA SERIES: THE NAZI HOLOCAUST - SERIES II — On January 30, 1939, just four months after the fall of Czechoslovakia, Hitler addressed the Reichstag. In a long speech he made it quite clear what the Jews could expect from his hands. He said: "Today I will once more be a prophet. If the international Jewish financiers inside and outside Europe should again succeed in plunging the nations into a world war, the result will be . . . the annihilation of the Jewish race throughout Europe." The holocaust would actually begin with the invasion of Russia. Although, with the fall of Czechoslovakia, almost 130,000 Jews fell into the hands of the Gestapo.
