THAT the April 6, 1959 order of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, admitting the defendant to United States citizenship is null and void, and the Clerk of this Court is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Judgment to the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, so that the records of the said Court shall reflect this ' Judgment; and

THAT Certificate of Naturalization number 8094737 in the name Otto Albrecht Alfred von Bolschwing is cancelled;

THAT within twenty days of the entry of this judgment, the defendant Otto Albrecht Alfred von Bolschwing or his duly authorized representative surrender the aforesaid Certificate of Naturalization to the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of California, who shall transmit it to the Director of the Office of Special Investigations, United States Department of Justice, for proper disposition according to the laws and regulations pertaining to the Immigration and Naturalization Service; and

THAT all provisions of the Settlement Agreement shall be enforced as an order of this Court.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

OTTO ALBRECHT ALFRED von BOLSCHWING,

WHEREAS the United States of America has filed a complaint in denaturalization against Otto Albrecht Alfred von Bolschwing (von Bolschwing) alleging numerous acts on his part; and

WHEREAS von Bolschwing has admitted his membership in the Nazi Party, SS, and SD, and denied all other allegations in the denaturalization complaint; and

WHEREAS the parties wish to settle the case a mutually accepted basis; and

WHEREAS von Bolschwing desires to voluntarily surrender his certificate of naturalization;

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties as follows:

- l. von Bolschwing has been diagnosed by a competent physician acceptable to both parties as having supranuclear palsy, a progressive neurological disorder with disabling features that include a rigidity in and an impairment of memory and intellectual functioning.
- 2. The United States of America may, at its own expense, retain the services of John A. Schafer, M.D., or in 'the event of his unavailability, another physician acceptable to both parties, to prepare an annual report concerning von Bolschwing's medical conditions. This report may be based on consultations with von Bolschwing's treating physicians and such examinations by Dr., Schafer as he deems necessary. von Bolschwing and his physicians will cooperate fully in such consultation and report and Dr. Schafer will conduct such consultations and examination in a reasonable manner on reasonable notice to von Bolschwing and his treating physicians. The report prepared by Dr. Schafer on October 20, 1981, shall be deemed the first annual report. Subsequent consultations, examinations, and reports shall be conducted during the last quarter of the calendar year.
- ment to the Court, accompanied by a proposed consent judgment revoking von Bolschwing's Certificate of Naturalization and the court order granting him said certificate, pursuant to 8 U.S.C. §1451(a). Within twenty days following said submission, von Bolschwing or his attorney will voluntarily surrender von Bolschwing's Certificate of Naturalization to the Office of the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of California, 3305 Federal Building, 650 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California.

- 4. Defendant agrees to waive any claimed right of appeal as to the voluntary surrender of his. Certificate of Naturalization or the aforesaid consent judgment pertaining thereto.
- 5. The United States of America agrees to forebear from initiating any deportation (including, but not limited to the issuance of an order to show cause) or exclusion proceeding against von Bolschwing as long as von Bolschwing is diagnosed as suffering from supranuclear palsy, or any other disorder which similarly disables memory and intellectual functioning.
- 6. Upon execution of this Agreement, von Bolschwing will not be subject to any federal criminal prosecution on charges arising out of his statements to immigration authorities on June 26, 1979 and February 2, 1981.
