The program outlined above will, if carried out through adequate financial support, go a long way towards solving the problems facing Europe's surviving 1,400,000 Jews.

It is not, of course, the complete answer, but the more that American Jews contribute, the more European Jews will be saved from starvation and rehabilitation for Judaiam.

Our institutions and services—orphan homes, provision of kosher food, religious articles, support of Yeshivoth, re-uniting families—are spread across Europe and Asia—from France to Iran, to Siberia and Shanghai.

Four orphan homes are functioning today in France. Yeshivoth and other educational institutions are functioning in France, Belgium, Hungary, Poland, Turkestan, Bokhara—and even in the motorious Belsen concentration camp.

In 14 countries today—Germany, France, Holland, Belgium, Poland, Sweden, Palestine, Italy, Hungary, Roumania, Slovakia, Austria, Iran and China—Vaad Hatsala, with the help of American Jewry, extends its far flung services.

With many limitations removed and with various facilities—including transportation and goods—becoming more available, we call on the American Jewish community, the strongest in the world, to make possible the increased aid that Jewish war survivers in Europe need.

One of our biggest jobs is child reclamation. Thousands of Jewish war orphans were hidden in Christian homes, cloisters and monasteries, when their parents were seized by Naris. Their past maintenance must be paid for and they must be returned to the Jewish fold. Mesengers must go from bouse to bouse, from monastery to monastery to seek out these children and negotiate for their return. Maintenance alone for these children is \$3300 a year.

In short, the entire field of Jewish religious and humanitarian settivities—as indicated by the accompanying budget—is our responsibility for 1946.

UNDERGROUND RING SAVED THOUSANDS DURING WAR

A Dramatic Report of Rescue Work
While Battles Raged

Highlights of Past Achievements

- Thousands of Jews throughout Europe saved from Nazi gas chambers and transferred to Switzerland, others saved from danger sense and maintained in hiding.
- Thousands of men, women and children shaltered in Siberia with food and clothing, since the start of the war.
- Hundreds of scholars and rabbis rescued from Poland and maintained in Shanghai since 1940.
- ⊕ Tons upon tons of keeher food and clothing distributed to refugee since V-E Day.
- · Schools and homes for refugees established in Iran.
- Thousands of orphans removed from non-Jewish homes, housed and supported in Jewish environments in France, Belgium, Holland, Switzerland and Sweden.
- Centers established for wast numbers of children and adults in Sweden where kosher kitchens have been maintained for them.
- Five synagogue-ambulances sent to the notorious Bergen Belsen Concentration Camp, equipped with food, medication and religious springles.
- Three ambulances routed to Peland, loaded with necessities, including clothing.

The story of Vaad Hatzala—beginning in 1939—reads like a melodrama, except that real people and matters of life and death are concerned. All the devices of intrigue—underground activity, bribes, spying and the like—have been utilized and they all added up to the saving of Jewish lives. (Full details may be found in a reprint of a New York Harald Tribune article on page 4).

[Vaad Hatsala was formed by The Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the U. S. A. and Canada with the cooperation of the deans of European and American theological seminaries. The very nature of Vaad's work at once attracted the attention and cooperation of all rabbinical bodies and leading American organizations.]

Outstanding among these thrilling accomplishments of Vaad Hatzala was its penetration inside enemy lines, even into the impregnable Nazi concentration camps themselves, to feed and rescue imprisoned Jews. (Described by Mayor O'Dwyer of New York City, former Executive Director of the War Refugee Board, in a report in the New York Times, reprinted on page 4).

It is difficult to estimate just how many Jews were saved by the Vaad Hatsala underground system, but it is definitely known that 3,000 were taken into Switserland in the three months before V-E Day.

One of our most dramatic rescues was carried out in Hungary in December, 1944. A trainload of 1,775 Jews was headed for an extermination camp, but negotiations by us saved them. At a cost of \$300,000 for traveling documents, passports, and other necessities, we transferred these documed souls to asse places.

Outstanding in our work among children was the initiation of religious rehabilitation for thousands of Sephardic children found reaming in Iran.

Another of our proud accomplishments was our work in the field of learning. One of Jewry's great losses in the war was the destruction of Yeshivoth and the extermination of its Rabbis and scholars. We were able to rescue a small remnant and since 1940 we have maintained more than 600 sages and students in Shanghai, even while the city was under Japanese domination.

For wanderers who finally settled in Siberia and other places in Asiatic Russia, we have supplied necessities to some 5,000 persons, mostly rabbis and scholars. We have, since 1940, sent food and religious articles from the U. S. A., Teheran and Palestine. In this work, with the cooperation of Russian War Relief. we received help from the Soviet Union, which shipped and admitted our supplies without any expense to us.
