up and every fifth man was taken out and shot.

But this was small-scale murder compared to what happened in Poland, where they all had their initiation of Nazi brutality. There the SS Guards were encouraged to kill on the slightest provocation. Eighty per cent of the inmates at one concentration camp "disappeared" in the first six months' period, and all Jews were killed as soon as they arrived. The customary procedure was to take Jews directly through to the lethal gas chambers and from there their bodies were reduced to dust at the crematory.
