Stalin Wins Major Fruits of War II Victory

Marshal Joseph Stalin, from Asia, and absolute dictator of totalitarian, Communist, imperialist Soviet Russia, has won and for his country the major fruits of Allied victory in World War II.

That can boldly be stated without fear of contradiction. THE RED NAPOLEON OF THE EAST IS MAKING ALL PEOPLES IN THE WEST SEE THAT FACT, EVEN THOUGH THEY DID NOT WANT TO SEE IT.

Stalin, the Asiatic, has outmaneuvered and ouplayed the statesmen of America and the British Empire.

Stalin, the son of a Tartar shoemaker, has fulfilled the 200-year-old dreams of the Russian Czars.

The territorial frontiers of Soviet Russia now extend to the very center of the European continent.

The frontiers of Soviet Communism are not halted there. Berlin, Vienna, Koenigsberg, Stettin and Warsaw are in Stalin's hands.

Stalin is the master of the Baltic Sea.

In the north he stands on the Atlantic in Norway.

In the south his pan-Slav viceroy ally, Tito, is attacking Fiume on the Adriatic and, with the support of Moscow, is demanding Trieste.

In Ankara, Stalin is demanding that Turkey surrender the keys to the Turkish Bosphorus and the Dardanelles, and take her sovereign locks off those straits.

It is something like demanding that America give up her sovereignty and military control of the Panama Canal.

In Stalin's Red bag are Finland, Poland, Romania, Hungary, Bulgaria, Yugoslavia, Czechoslovakia, the three former free independent republics of Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia, and now Austria and half of Germany.

It is truly a good bag for one war. NAPOLEON COULD SHOW NOTHING LIKE IT.

There has been nothing like it since the Roman Empire MADRID, Spain, April 28.—The Red armies are of Julius Caesar, 2000 years ago, and the Mongol Tartar empire of Genghis Khan in the 13th century.

It is scarcely believable that this was the objective, aim ultimate goal of American and British statesmanship.

The astounding lack of vision and foresight in statesmanship, and the grievous miscalculations in the political strategy of those who wanted to remap and reorganize the world, brought this about.

For 16 months I have consistently pointed out the certainty of the present outcome of the course that was

being pursued.

Such is the part of the world picture that confronts the San Francisco Conference which, among other actions, is expected to guarantee Soviet Russia her great bag, at the same time being unable to prevent the addition of other imperialistic Russian gains, since Stalin's vast realm is one of the Big Five "untouchables" in any aggressions it might make.

Touch of Childishness

Under the Dumbarton Oaks plan of the late President Roosevelt, the congress of nations at San Francisco would create three worlds of inequality.

There would be that of the Big Five, whose might is right, the world of smaller nations, who are expected to believe in and rely upon "their moral strength" and in "justice," and the world of pariah Germany and Japan.

In turn, these would be divided into a world of democracy and a world of totalitarian Soviet Communism.

THEY WOULD ALSO BE DIVIDED INTO A WORLD OF RELIGION AND A WORLD OF ATHEISM.

The belief that the "untouchable" five will forever keep peace among themselves, because they are big and mighty, and will commit no aggression against a smaller and weaker neighbor, because of their own high moral principles and ethics, has a touch of childishness and has no basis in human nature and no support whatsoever in

THE BEST PROOF OF THAT IS POLAND AND ROMANIA.

It is well nigh inconceivable to think that the smaller nations, assembled in San Francisco of their own volition, will forge handcuffs on their wrists and leg-irons on their ankles, or permit them to be forged so they may become easy victims of aggression on the part of the unshackled five big fellows.

It stands against common sense, no matter how wrapped in flowery legalistic phraseology.

There must be reestablished the authority of law, the sanctity of human life, the security of freedom and the restoration through those three, of faith in God and

There can be no authority in or universal respect for law without absolute equality before the law of the highest and most powerful, with the smallest and weakest.

THAT FORMULA SHOULD APPLY TO NA-TIONS AS WELL AS TO INDIVIDUALS.

If that is not the foundation and the keystone to the arch of the proposed World Security League, then it is foredoomed to collapse and it were better not to be created.

THE ENTRANCE OF STALIN'S RED ARMIES INTO BERLIN WILL BRING FAR AND WIDE REP-ERCUSSIONS IN EUROPE; SOME OF THEM, AS YET, UNSUSPECTED.

As an historic event it has been somewhat overshadowed or blurred in Europe by the sensational Drew Pear-

son allegations in dispatches from New York and Washington that President Roosevelt had given General Eisenhower orders to hold back American forces, so that the Red armies should be the first to enter Berlin, thus giving Stalin the fame and prestige, and Soviet Russia the glory, in history, of taking the German capital.

The assertion that it was a part of the secret agreement in the Crimean conference between Roosevelt, Churchill and Stalin created no little amazement and seemed to inject a sinister note into the Yalta declaration.

Beginning of Last Phase

When the spearhead of Eisenhower's American Ninth Army came into contact with units of the Red army of Soviet Russia in central Germany, two widely separated worlds met and looked into each other's eyes in the pivotal center of the European continent, they understood one another not at all.

Symbolically, it was more significant than the en-

trance of the Red armies into Berlin.

It was the beginning of the last phase of the war against Nazi Germany in which America, Britain and Soviet Russia were associates.

That meeting, too, was the beginning of a new conflict for the soul of Europe between the two worlds of totalitarian Communism and the dictatorship system of the East, and the democracy, individualism, freedom and private property rights of the West.

With death, despair, destruction, devastation, unemployment, hunger and disease as its most active agents, Communism and Socialism have as great an advantage over democracy as the Allied armies in men and material had over the Wehrmacht.

It is one of the greatest paradoxes and saddest ironies of man that in striving in this war to establish true democracy with its freedoms in Europe we have steamrollered the way for Soviet Communism and her unfreedoms. And in aiming to destroy two Nazi Fascist arbitrary dictatorial systems and powers we have achieved the elevation to world power of another, far greater and stronger, absolute dictatorship system.

Pattern Becomes Clear

That should go far to explain Moscow's actions in

Poland, Romania and Hungary.

The Kremlin wants a Europe of private and propertyless Communists, since possession of private property of any kind influences the political thought of such owners against Communism and Communist Soviet Russia.

That makes the pattern clear.

THE CONFLICT BETWEEN THOSE TWO WORLDS, SO FUNDAMENTALLY OPPOSED, CAN-NOT BE ENDED BY ANY FORMULA OF WORDS ADOPTED IN SAN FRANCISCO.
