BIRCHMONT, A Summer Camp for Adults, is at East Wolfeboro, N. H., halfway between the towns of Sanbornville and Wolfeboro, seven miles either way, and about 110 miles from Boston.

Cotton Valley, the railroad station, is three miles from Camp, on the Wolfeboro branch of the Boston & Maine R.R.

The Camp includes a quarter mile of shore on Lake Wentworth, a beautiful lake five miles long connecting with Lake Winnepesaukee at Wolfeboro.

Eighty acres of woods and fields are included in the grounds: 50 acres of forest and a 30-acre campus, on a hilltop around which cabins are located, nestled among the pines.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Birchmonters live in individual cabins, furnished and cared for by the Camp. Meals are served on the dining porch of the main bunga-

Birchmonters live in individual cabins, furnished and cared for by the Camp. Meals are served at the main bungalow, on the dining porch adjoining the living room, with electric lights, fieldstone fireplace, piano and games, and washrooms, with hot and cold running water.

View

From the campus and from the broad piazzas surrounding the bungalow and glass enclosed dining porch, we never tire of watching the changing shadows on the distant mountains and the sunsets over the lake. Our elevation of nine hundred feet gives us this extended view, clear, dry air and good breezes.

Cabins

The cabins, carefully located for seclusion and beauty, accommodate from one to four people. They are cozy, have from one to three rooms, either a stove or a fireplace, are thoroughly screened, windows that slide open the full width, and some have wide porches.

An abundance of wood is furnished with each cabin. The single beds used have comfortable mattresses, with all blankets and linen provided and laundered by the Camp. Chamber work is done by the Camp and fresh water supplied.

There is one cabin with three rooms and porch, electric lights, bath with cold running water, and stove.

A solarium is provided for those who like to take their sun baths in large doses.
