**In Beth Chalutzoth – in the Hamburg Barracks, Room No. 305.** Room 305, in the House of Chalutzim, officially in the Hamburg Barracks, was home for Else Lichtblau (Elsa Leskly) and 25 other Jewish women. Erich Lichtblau recalls: *Every Friday evening there was Oneg Shabbat. They young people sang Hebrew songs and they learned Hebrew language. They lived with the dream to go after the liberation to Palestine.* Terezin, 1943.
