ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

- I. This *Who's Who in Germany and Austria* is the fifth edition of what was previously known as *Who's Who in Nazi Germany*. The information contained in it may be used without restriction, but the source must not be quoted.
- II. The number of personalities included in this edition has been considerably increased. This has involved a departure from the principle of earlier editions in which the different fields of German life were covered down to approximately the same rank. In this volume this has not been practicable.
- III. The *Who's Who* is divided into two main parts :—
 - (i) *Administrative Directory*, consisting of office holders and administrative personalities classified according to offices. This is sub-divided into :—
 - (a) *Central Authorities*, and
 - (b) *Regional Authorities*.For the sake of convenience there is a small overlap between the two sections.
 - (ii) *Alphabetical Directory*, giving, where possible, the main particulars of personalities (other than minor personalities) included in Part (i). In addition it contains the names of many other notable personalities and former office holders.
- IV. *Correlation Tables* have been added to this edition showing the relation between administrative, Party and military regions.
- V. The Survey of Changes included in the fourth edition has been discontinued.
- VI. It is proposed to keep this edition up to date by the regular issue of supplements which can be inserted at the end of the book.
- VII. Photographs of, and other material regarding, a large number of the personalities included in this volume are available. Application for such material or for further copies of the *Who's Who* should be made in writing to :—

CLASSES OF PERSONALITIES INCLUDED

This Who's Who includes :—

All persons in key posts of central and regional State and Party administration.

A number of prominent personalities in other fields of public life.

I. CENTRAL AUTHORITIES

A. State Authorities :

1. Government.

2. Reich Ministries.

3. Other Supreme Reich Authorities.

All officials in A.1, 2 and 3 down to the rank of *Ministerialrat* and persons who, though not holding this rank, are in positions equivalent to those normally held by *Ministerialräte*.

4. Police.

All officials in charge of divisions, sections or sub-sections of the two Central Police Departments of the Reich, HSSPF, BdO and BdS in all *Wehrkreise*.

B. Party Authorities :

1. Reich Directorate (*Reichsleitung*).

All officials down to the heads of the more important divisions (*Ämter*) of the *Reichsleitung* departments (*Reichsämter*, *Hauptämter*, *Oberämter*).

Heads of certain important sections (*Hauptstellen*).

The three principal Party officials in each Gau (*Gauleiter*, deputy *Gauleiter* and *Gauobmann* (DAF)).

The heads of Nazi Party groups in various foreign countries.

2. Heads of Formations.

The heads, deputy heads and the heads of important divisions of the various Party formations.

Area commanders of corps rank (in the case of the SS, also those of divisional rank).

3. Organisations affiliated to the Party.

Only the heads of such organisations. (The central executives shown as members of the departments of the *Reichsleitung* which control these affiliated organisations.) In the case of the DAF, fairly full coverage to the four principal divisions and a number of their important sections.

4. Organisations supervised by the Party.
The heads of these organisations.

C. Armed Forces :

1. High Command of all Armed Forces (OKW).

2. Army.

3. Navy.

4. Air Force.

The known heads of the most important divisions of the three High Commands.

Commanders of Military and Air Force districts.

All Generals (Admirals) down to and including full Generals (Admirals).

The Air Force includes the known heads, central and regional, of the NS-Flying Corps and of the Reich A.R.P. League (RLB).

5. Waffen-SS.

The known heads of the most important divisions of the *Waffen-SS* High Command.

All *Waffen-SS* generals down to *Obergruppenführer* and *General d. W.-SS*.

All other *Waffen-SS* generals commanding a corps.

D. Cultural Life :

1. Religion.

Archbishops and Bishops of the Roman Catholic Church and their equivalents in the Protestant Church.

Heads of other denominations and the more important sects, both Christian and Neo-Pagan.

2. Research and Science.

Heads of the most important scientific research institutes and the presidents of academies of science.

3. Reich Chamber of Culture.

Presidents and managers of the Reich Chamber of Culture and its six constituent chambers. Under each of these chambers, some of the most prominent artists falling under their jurisdiction.

Principal personalities connected with the most important national and regional papers and with important periodicals.

4. Broadcasting.

Chief executives and programme-directors of the German Broadcasting Corporation (RRG).

The best known political and military commentators who broadcast regularly.

E. Economic Life :

1. Economic Chambers.

Presidents and managers of the Central (Reich) and Regional (Gau) Economic Chambers.

2. Economic Groupings.

Heads and managers of the chief groupings of German economic life (*Reichsgruppen*, *Wirtschaftsgruppen* and *Reichsverkehrsgruppen*.)

3. Important Firms.

A list of the names of about 200 of the most important firms. (For details of staffs, see "Regional Authorities".)

F. Occupied Territories :

The last known principal German officials of all areas in Europe occupied at any time since 1938. (For parts incorporated into "Greater Germany," cross references are given to the relevant sections under "Regional Authorities".)

II. REGIONAL AUTHORITIES

All personalities included in "Central Authorities" are also dealt with in the "Alphabetical Directory." A number of less important personalities are included in "Regional Authorities" for reasons of convenience and do not reappear in the "Alphabetical Directory." Such personalities are printed in smaller type and are referred to below as "Class 2."

"Regional Authorities" is divided into 42 sections, each covering one Prussian Province, one former State (*Land*), or one *Reichsgau*.

Throughout the 42 sections the same classification of personnel is used:—

State Authorities.

Police.

Party Administration.

Armed Forces.

Cultural Life.

Economic Life.

A. State Authorities :

Administrative head (*Oberpräsident*, *Reichsstatthalter*).

Heads of the most important divisions of the *Höhere Verwaltungsbehörde* (*Oberpräsidium*, *Landesregierung*, *Reichsstatthalterei*).

Heads of the most important regional directorates of special administrative authorities such as Railways, Finance, etc., covering or partly covering the areas.

Regierungspräsidenten and *Oberbürgermeister* of towns of more than 100,000 inhabitants.

In class 2 all remaining *Oberbürgermeister* and all *Landräte*.

B. Police :

HSSPF, BdO and BdS.

Heads of all *Stapo-Leitstellen* and *Stapo-Stellen*. *Polizeipräsidenten* of all towns of more than 100,000 inhabitants.

In class 2, the remaining *Polizeipräsidenten*, *Polizeidirektoren*, heads of *Polizeämter*, heads of *Kripo-Leitstellen* and *Kripo-Stellen*, and *Stapo-Aussendienstellen*.

C. Party Administration :

Gauleiter and *Gauamtsleiter*.

Commanders of formations of corps rank (in the SS also of divisional rank).

In class 2, all *Kreisleiter*.

D. Armed Forces :

Commander of *Wehrkreis*.

Commander of *Luftgau*.

E. Cultural Life :

Heads of the Roman Catholic dioceses or Church provinces.

Heads of institutes of higher education, universities, etc.

Leading personnel of regional newspapers.

F. Economic Life.

Head and manager of the local *Gauwirtschaftskammer*.

Chairmen of Boards of Directors and Boards of Management of important firms which have their headquarters in the area.

In class 2 other members of these Boards, and Executives of branches of the Gau Economic Chambers.

Note : A number of the more important personalities in "Regional Administration" are also included, for convenience, in Part I, "Central Authorities," where they will be found under the Central Authority by which they are controlled. For instance, *Oberfinanzpräsidenten*, under "Reich Ministry of Finance"; Commanders of *Wehrkreise*, under "Army."

Administratur (Apostolische) : Roman Catholic ecclesiastical district, between diocese and parish.
